

[First Canadian Showing of new Zenair Cruzer kitplane](#)



Another first for the Waterloo Airshow and Canadian Aviation Expo: The first public appearance in Canada for the just introduced [Zenair CH 750 Cruzer](#), an all-metal 2-seat kit aircraft developed and manufactured right here in Ontario!

The Cruzer is a light sport aircraft that can be assembled at home from a kit in about 400 hours. Once finished, it can be flown with a regular private pilot's license, or with an ultralight license. The aircraft is designed to carry two people and luggage over 800 km on a tank of gas, at close to 200km/hr! Cost of the kit is under \$20,000 (without engine or instruments).

The new Cruzer was unveiled only last month in Florida at the annual "Sun'n Fun" trade show; the aircraft on display at the Waterloo Airshow is the actual prototype which was designed and built by Zenair Limited in Midland, ON. The 40-year-old company has a long line of successful and award-winning kit-plane designs to its credit. For more information, visit www.zenair.com
